Loved to the End

John 13:1 - Now before the Feast of the Passover, when Jesus knew that his hour had come to depart out of this world to the Father, having loved his own who were in the world, he loved them to the end.

The Apostle John records for us an event that no other gospel writer does and it takes place shortly before the death of Jesus. John says that Jesus took the role of a house servant and washed his disciples' feet. What this act reveals about the heart of Jesus should encourage us both to worship and imitation.

First, in taking the role of a servant, Jesus displayed his love. The passage begins by mentioning this phrase "having loved his own who were in the world, he loved them to the end." By washing their feet, and ultimately by dying on the cross, Jesus loved his disciples. Next, Jesus displayed humility. Yet again, the King of Kings humbled himself by performing the task of a servant. He would do so again at the cross. Finally, Jesus performed this task towards men who would soon betray him. Yet He loved them to the end. We are called to love one another (Jn 13:34-35). This is when we are most like Jesus. Love one another, "to the end."
